



Overview of Journal of Hepatology in 2002


Total # of Submissions: 960 (all papers) 708 (original papers)

Editorial Processing Time: average 40 days





Manual Manuscript Processing

- 5 Paper Copies of Manuscript received via post/courier
- File for each Manuscript (space for 1,000 manuscripts per year)
- Copy sent to associate editor, reviewers and publisher

Major Overheads:

- Fax Machine
- Post and Courier Services,
- Journal of Hepatology Stationery.
- Change of Editorial Office (every 5 years)

Online Manuscript Processing

Advantages:

- Authors upload their own papers from their computer
- All communication is done via the system and email
- Administrative Control of the Ms review process done online.
- Reduction in Costs: less paper, no sending Ms. Via post/courier, fax and telephone bills have been reduced.
- Communication and review process is quicker.
- Change of Editorial Office will be easier.

Disadvantages:

- Cost of Implementation
- Technical Problems (speed of connection, servers down, compatibility of files uploaded.)
- Less Flexibility in workflow
